### Govt launches Chakshu portal to report fraud calls, messages

NEW DELHI: Government on Monday unveiled the Chakshu portal under the umbrella of Sanchar Sathi to enable subscribers to report fraud calls, messages like lottery offer, job offers and even suspected leak of phone numbers by businesses.

Union IT and Communications Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said that through digital measures to check fraud and crime, the Department of Telecom Services has been able to help citizens save around Rs 1,000 crore in the last nine months and Rs 1,008 crore has been frozen in various bank accounts that were linked to

fraudulent transactions.

"Chakshu is about reporting something which people suspect is fraud," he said.

When asked about the process put in place on mobile numbers that are leaked by businesses, the minister said that subscribers can report about the number of leaks on the Chakshu portal and action will be taken against the culprit. He said that 1 crore mobile numbers have been disconnected in the last nine months that were linked to malicious activities.

The DoT also unveiled the Digital Intelligence Platform that will coordinate and share

information with law enforcement agencies, banks and other financial agencies to act on fraud. "With the Chakshu and Digital Intelligence Platform, we think the pace at which we were able to detect and prevent cyber frauds will significantly improve," Vaishnaw said.

He said that there will be an investigation carried out on the reported number and action will be taken thereafter. Vaishnaw said that the ministry is working with financial institutions including RBI to recover money, and prevent and freeze accounts in which money has been transferred fraudulently. PTI

THE Department of Telecommunications (DoT) on Monday launched new portal Chakshu that will enable people to report fraudulent calls, SMS, and WhatsApp messages received within the last 30 days.

The DoT launched a digital

The DoT launched a digital intelligence platform (DIP) that will provide a single platform to share data about suspected fraudulent connections. The platform will offer opportunity to share data or numbers with all stakeholders, including payment wallets, law enforcement agencies, and other user agencies like IRCTC. Once reported, the telecom service providers will undertake re-verification of those numbers. Upon failing re-verification, the numbers will be disconnected.

"With the digital intelligence platform, data will be shared, almost in real-time, with all stakeholders in case of suspected fraud... Law enforcement, banks, and financial service providers can provide details on a single platform," said telecom minister Ashwini Vaishnaw.

Since the launch of Sanchar Sathi portal, frauds worth ₹1,008 crore have been prevented. The portal was launched on May 16, 2023; since then, it has disconnected 59 lakh fraudulent mobile connections; over 1 crore handsets linked to cybercrime were blocked; Sanchar Saathi identified and blacklisted 1.5 lakh point-of-sale (PoS) terminals suspected of fraudulent activity; and 71,000 FIRs (first information reports) were registered based on evidence gathered through the portal.

और वॉलेट ऑपरेटर के बीच साइबर अपराधियों का डेटा साझा करने में मदद मिलेगी। इस मौके पर आईटी मंत्री अश्विनी वैष्णव ने कहा कि फ्रॉड से जुड़े डेटा को सभी स्टेकहोल्डर के साथ रियल टाइम में साझा किया जा सकेगा।
